BOSTON CHIEF broke on top, vied for the lead along the three path, battled in the lane, responded and drove clear late. SMOKIN WARRIOR vied for the lead three abreast early, dueled on the bend, could not match stride late but finished well. CLERY'S CONTENDER lagged back, four path on the turn and then closed well. HALLIGAN was well placed along the three path on the turn and weakened. MILLER'S MINT lagged back, saved ground on the turn and then finished wide. LAPIN fractious in the gate, three path on the turn and then lacked a solid bid. STAR OF ROME four path on the turn and then finished wide. PRO'S PAL broke in the air, vied for the lead from between early and tired. LAKE BUTLER five wide on the bend and tired.
