MAC LADY broke sharply, set the pace along the three path and then widened to win handily. CHAIN LETTER lagged back, six wide on the turn, launched a bid and rallied to earn the place. BED PRO tracked the winner along the four path, chased in the lane and then missed the place. WE'LL SEA YA was unhurried along the four path on the turn, angled out in the lane and made a late bid. CLIFDEN STAR was well placed while five wide on the turn, lodged a bid and weakened. SEA OF HOPE was never far back along the three path and then tired. LIVEITUPNOW saved ground while close up to the lane and tired.
