MISSILETOE KISS contested the lead from between foes on the turn, continued between in the lane, matched strides from the sixteenths pole to the line with OUR PINK RIBBON and got the nod over the latter for the win. OUR PINK RIBBON vied for the three across on the turn, continued outside foes fighting for the lead with a furlong to go, battled with the winner to line and was out bobbed for the win. METAXIE vied for the lead along the rail on the turn, battled inside a furlong out and weakened. NOT CLOSE stumbled at the start, four path on the turn, angled out and finished with interest. AWESOMEATTHETRACK was well placed along the rail, in tight at the half mile pole, checked, saved ground on the turn and weakened. INSTANT FLASH lagged far back, three path around the bend and then failed to take part. WIRE TAP saved ground, in tight at the half mile pole, checked and tired. BITTERSWEET BABY was unhurried along the rail and tired.
