RAF'S SOCIETY GIRL stalked the leader along the rail, gained on the last turn, quickly took command, opened up daylight and then finished gamely to just miss. SHADY LANE was never far back along the four path, three path on the last turn and hung. NICOLE KATHRYN lagged far back along the rail, angled out in the lane and then lacked a rally. GOLD FLINGER an early factor, entered the lane five wide, weakened, returned sore and was vanned off. LOOKIN' SWELL gained along the three path up the backstretch and weakened. HOOSICK FALLS set the pace in hand along the four path, bolted on the last and tired.
