SUNDAY DREAMER assumed the lead, set the pace off the rail, was hooked late, appeared beat but came back on for the win. ADMIRAL BIRD was unhurried, gained four wide on the turn, collared the winner, looked like a winner but yielded in the crucial stages. BISTRO SOIREE was well placed, two path on the turn and then bested SUNNY BOY 'N BEN for the show. SUNNY BOY 'N BEN E tracked along the three path, chased and then missed the show. JUST A WHIM close up early, three path on the turn and made a mild bid. SENEGAL saved ground and weakened. LUKE'S FLASH three path on the bend, was outrun. HARD DECISION broke sluggishly, two path on the turn, was outrun. EARLY RESPONSE four path on the turn and tired. TRI CRUSADING five wide on the turn and tired.
