Footnotes

LA TRAVIESA was unhurried off the rail, three path on the last turn, tracked the leader, challenged in midstretch, responded and drove clear. BRINGHOMETHELOOT tracked the leader along the three path, dueled after a half mile, clear into the lane, was collared in midstretch, battled some and then finished second best. SHINE FOR lagged back off the rail, lacked room nearing the quarter pole, checked, angled out and then made a late gain for a share. FLEETENGLY was unhurried off the rail, eased out in the lane and then improved her position. O'ELL was well placed along the four path to the last turn and weakened. LILLIAN'S VALLEY five wide on the first turn, wide after a half mile, angled to the three path on the last turn and weakened. WATASHA set the pace early, dueled after a half mile, chased and tired. IN ONE BASKET dropped out of it, appeared to be in distress and was eased.
