MIGHTY DAWN was well placed along the four path, gained ground into the lane, quickly took command and then under the whip held sway for the win. VIVA BLANDA was never far back along the rail, angled out into the lane, lodged a bid, gained on the winner and then finished second best. ACKYBACKY four path on the first turn, saved ground after a half mile, gained some on the final bend, lodged a bid and hung. RUPERT'S APPROVAL lagged back along the four path, angled out in the lane and then lacked a solid bid. DOBIES LITTLE GIRL was unhurried up the backstretch, four path on the last turn and then lacked a rally. RED LEAVE ROSE checked at the three-quarter pole to avoid the loose horse, vied for the lead early, shook loose, showed the way, was hooked quickly and tired. SPICED vied for the lead off the rail early, chased after a half mile and tired. RARE HONOR stumbled badly at the start unseating the jockey. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning the start resulted in no change.
