AL'S DEPUTY gained inside on the turn, collared the leader along the rail at the top of the lane, battled, responded and drew off. TOO TOUGH PETE broke sluggishly, checked just after the start, saved ground, eased out some in the lane and rallied for the place. BAMBI BOUND vied for the lead along the four path on the turn, battled the winner and weakened. BLUESPOWERHOUSE well placed off the rail early and then failed to threaten. HIDDEN EXPENSE saved ground, was not a factor. PRO'S PAL vied for the lead along the three path to the lane and gave way. SEVEN FIRSTS two path on the bend and tired.
