Footnotes

WINNERS LAUGH rated nicely on the front end, turned back a challenged through the turn, shook clear in the lane, then drew off and was ridden out. JILLUKE stalked the pace on the outside, moved up to challenge through the turn, could not go with the winner into the stretch, stayed on and held the place safe. BEDROCK BLUES well back and outside, moved up three wide through the turn, fanned widest into the stretch and closed well in the lane to get up for the show. COCOBOLO mid pack and off the rail, moved through the turn on the two path, bid between rivals into the stretch and ran evenly. EVAN'S EMERALD ran evenly. AGAIN ELEVEN tracked the pace on the inside, angled out to bid four wide and had no stretch rally.
