MACHO MUCHACHO well back, moved up four wide through the second turn, bid on that path into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drew off under mild urging. COME ON OVER tracked the pace on the inside while pulling, angled out and moved up three wide to take command through the second turn, then could not match strides with the winner the final furlong and held the place safe. HURLING well back and off the rail, moved up on the two path through the second turn, came three wide to bid and lacked the needed late kick. GOOD KARMA void of speed, moved up inside through the second turn, steadied slightly into the stretch, then angled out for clear racing room and got up for a share. SMALL TOWN stalked the pace on the outside, moved up through the backstretch to gain a short lead, then had no stretch rally. CLASS CLOWN hard to rated early, was well placed and three wide, then was through after a half. NORTHERN BANDIT set the early pace and stopped.
