RUN MIKEY RUN was well placed in hand, angled out in the lane, responded when roused, gained the lead late and then was ridden out to the line. LT. JOSEF broke on top, showed the way along the three path, was hooked and then held the place. DAY OF SUFFERING six wide up the backstretch, five wide on the turn, chased and finished with interest. BIG OUT was unhurried, angled wide in the lane and closed well. YOU WILLGO BROKE five wide up the backstretch, four path between foes on the turn and weakened late. MT. MAJESTY was unhurried, three path on the turn and then lacked a rally. JUST A WHIM was well placed along the three path and weakened. MERLIN CIRCLE stumbled at the start, lagged far back and then finished wide. COLLEGE POINT BLVD saved ground and tired.
