DAVID IS MAD tracked, challenged three across midway on the final turn, battled in the lane to no avail but finished with interest. CLASS CLOWN set the pace off the rail, was hooked on the last turn, battled some and tired. WISE GUY KELLY never far back, saved ground on the turns and weakened.
