GREAT PRESS saved ground early, angled out to the three path on the turn, tracked to no avail but finished well. SINGING EMPRESS slow to settle, two path on the turn, angled out and then was going well late. JETINA three path on the turn, angled out and then failed to take part. ROARING GINGER saved ground and weakened. RICH'S SPITFIRE saved ground on the turn, lost the whip in upper stretch and weakened. DESERT DOCTOR two path well placed on the bend and tired. BORO KID three path on the corner and tired.
