**Footnotes**

STAR OF ROME set the pace on the inside, shook clear in the stretch and held under steady pressure. DAYS OF LIGHTNING vied for the early lead from between rivals, came three wide to bid and lacked the needed late kick. WILDCAT STEVIE tracked the pace on the inside, got through inside of rivals into the stretch and weakened in the drive. WESTERN JET broke a step slowly and was well placed and three wide, bid on that path into the stretch, closed well in the late going to get up for a share. POINT CUMANA well placed and between rivals, passed tiring rivals in the lane. ELEGANT JETSETTER hard to rate in the early going three wide, came four wide to bid and flattened out. CONCORDE'S DANCER well placed and four wide, came five wide to bid and had no stretch rally.
