GURDARSH sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, was never challenged, drew off in the lane under steady pressure. GREAT BEAR chased the pace on the outside, bid outside of that one into the stretch, closed willingly through the lane to be clearly best of the rest. QUIETISM had a three wide trip and got up for the show, while no threat to the top two. DOUBLE WHAM stumbled at the start, chased the pace from between rivals and weakened. FIVE FREEDOMS had an inside trip and was no factor.
