### Footnotes

PRO'S PAL broke well, sprinted clear, was hooked at the top of the lane, responded when roused and drew off. DEMOCRAT gained along the three path on the turn, angled wide in the lane and finished with good energy. WESTERN DEED was well placed five wide on the turn and finished with interest. CLERY'S CONTENDER broke sluggishly, five wide on the turn, angled in some and then failed to be a factor. EARLY RESPONSE stalked while five wide on the turn, challenged at the top of the lane, battled briefly and faded. BARCO broke sluggishly, five wide on the turn and tired.
