PETE BEACH was unhurried along the rail and made a late bid. HIGHER DESIRE vied for the lead four across early, three across midway on the turn and then faded. JILLY WILLY was well placed, checked midway on the turn and weakened. PATTON'S LEGACY three path on the turn and then failed to threaten. ONE CLASSY LADY two path on the turn and tired.
