KIMRY MOOR was never far back along the four path, angled out five wide into the lane, moved to challenge while three across the track with a furlong to go, responded to the whip and drove clear. CAT IN DEED vied for the lead along the four path while three abreast, battled between foes in midstretch and then finished second best. LINDASLADYLUCK vied for the lead from between foes, battled nearest the rail in the lane and then weakened. OOLA BOOLA six wide on the turn, continued wide in the lane and then lacked a solid bid. LITTLE SURFER off the rail on the turn, eased out in the lane and then lacked a closing bid. HELLO JUDY four path on the turn, was not a factor. INSPIRE vied for the lead along the rail to the lane and gave way. MINTAGE showed little.
