HONEY'S BRUTUS gained four wide on the turn, quickly took the lead, responded when roused and widened to be ridden out. N B RAVENS was unhurried along the two path, responded in the lane and rallied for the place. EVER SO FAST challenged from between three deep at the top of the lane, chased and then missed the place. CORUSCATION tracked, challenged between foes two deep at the quarter pole and weakened. BLUE HORSESHOE broke slow, three path into the lane and then failed to gain. I WAITED PATIENTLY set the pace along the rail, was hooked nearing the quarter pole and gave way.
