Footnotes

WILDCAT'S SMILE was unhurried along the two path, gained into the lane, angled out, responded and rallied under the whip to take the lead and was going at the end. FRENCH WINE tracked the leader along the three path, challenged in midstretch, battled but could handle the winner while besting BAY PARK BOY for the place. BAY PARK BOY vied for the lead three across early, cleared along the two path on the turn, was hooked, battled and finished well. JAW CRUSHER vied for the lead from between early, saved ground on the turn and weakened. KALL ME SIG was well placed along the two path on the bend and weakened. SMOKEM'S CHARM was well placed early, four wide into the lane and weakened. TAX RETURN was unhurried along the three path and tired. NO FLAWS forced the issue early along the rail, checked from the seven-sixteenths pole to the three-eighths pole and tired. ZOW stumbled at the start and unseated the jockey. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning the start, resulted in no change.
