SMALL TOWN lagged back, gained along the two path on the last turn, angled out and rallied for the win. MATCH STICK vied for the lead, shook clear on the last turn, widened in the lane and then couldn't last. DAVID IS MAD was unhurried, saved ground on the turns, eased out and finished well. AOJA three path on the first turn, in striking distance on the last turn and weakened. FAVORITE COLORS three path on the last turn and then failed to take part. PIZZARIA lagged far back, saved ground on the last turn, was outrun. FORTYNINEGEORGEST. three path on the turns, was not a factor. MOMSBOY hit the gate at the start, well placed up the backstretch and tired. OUTSIDE LOVE vied for the lead, two path on the turns and gave way.
