### Footnotes

READING GLASSES stalked the pace on the outside, moved up and angled in to come through inside the leader into the stretch, then made a steady gain and drove clear late. SHA SHEAR EGO sprinted to a clear lead well off the rail, stayed on when challenged the final furlong, could not match strides with the winner, while clearly best of the rest. WILDCAT'S ELEMENT tracked the pace on the inside, ran evenly to the stretch, then weakened in the drive, while holding the show safe. YOUR TUNE ANYTIME ran evenly. DISCO BEAT steadily lost ground. POKA DOTTIE was no factor. ARTIST'S VISION stumbled badly after the start and lost the rider.
