BRAZEN KAT never far back along the rail, eased out, took dead aim on ALCANDUDANCE with a furlong to go and nailed that one on the line. ALCANDUDANCE vied for the lead along the two path, took charge in midstretch, was hooked, battled and just missed. FINAL PEAK reared at the start spotting the field three lengths, gained along the three path into the lane and rallied. CALL TIGER was unhurried, two path on the turn, eased out and finished with interest. DRINK AT LAST CALL was unhurried, three path on the turn and weakened. SEEKING ELDORADO vied for the lead along the rail and gave way. CAJUN JET was well placed along the three path to the lane and tired. DONT BLAME THE CAT three path on the turn and tired.
