KNOTENUFMONEYHUNNY lagged back, gained ground along the five path leaving the backstretch, angled out six wide into the lane and rallied for the win. CAKE WALK was well placed along the four path, gained the lead midway on the last turn, opened up some in the lane and just missed at the line. RUBY PRINCESS bumped hard at the start by STAR SEQUENCE, five wide on the first turn, gained leaving the backstretch, chased into the lane and then weakened. LUCK 'N DEVOTION lagged back along the rail, eased out some in the lane and then lacked the late needed response. STAR SEQUENCE bumped hard with RUBY PRINCESS at the start, six wide on the first turn, gained ground into the lane and then flattened out. JACQUES CORONET set the pace early along the rail and then was done on the last turn. NO MORE BARRY saved ground, was not a factor. CHICADEED forced the issue early, dropped back, lost contact with his and was distanced.
