WISE GUY KELLY in hand, gained on the last turn, blocked nearing the quarter pole, checked hard, stumbled, found an opening in upper stretch and drew off to be ridden out. CAMPANA was unhurried along the rail, gained inside on the last turn, quickly took the lead and then was no match for the winner. RELATIVELY READY was unhurried, three path on the turns, eased out and finished with interest. TOM'S PRIMETIME lagged far back, entered the lane four wide and then found his best stride late. CHUCKIE'S HONOR was well placed along the three path on the turns and weakened. ADAM BOY five wide on the first turn, four path on the last turn and then was erratic through the stretch. BADGE OF RED broke on top, set the pace along the two path, vied for the lead after a half mile and then was done entering the lane. DUKES COUNTY vied for the lead after a half mile to the quarter pole and gave way.
