DELIVERY set the pace on the inside, shook clear through the turn, then drew off in the lane while being kept to the task. JABEZ never far back and outside, looped three wide through the turn, came four wide to bid and got up for the place while no threat to the winner. THUNDER ROARING tracked the pace on the inside, raced boxed through the turn, angled out and bid four wide, no late gain. SILVER WILLOW allowed to settle, moved up four wide through the turn, bid on that path and weakened in the drive. CATILLAC CUTIE well back, moved up on the two path through the turn, angled out to bid four wide and had a mild gain in the lane. FLY CAT mid pack and inside, moved through the turn on the rail, came through inside of rivals and lost ground. BREEZY SUMMER was a brief factor. BUMBLEBEE BOOGIE sent from the gate, stalked the early pace and stopped. MY PERCEPTIVE GIRL was never involved, widest. SINGLE THOUGHT was no factor.
