QUEENIES GIRL lagged far back off the rail, angled out five wide into the lane, responded readily when asked and then closed fast to be along in time. CARR QUEEN vied for the lead along the three path, battled in the lane, gained a slim lead late and then just missed. STORMING RENEE vied for the lead off the lead, battled in the lane and then finished well to narrowly miss. HEAR ME ROAR was unhurried along the three path on the turn, lodged a bid outside in the lane and hung. BUY THE FOUR N TEN was unhurried early, gained ground while six wide outside rivals on the turn and then flattened out. SAMS HALO lagged back along the three path and then lacked a rally. KITTEN ON THE KEYS was well placed from between foes midway on the turn and then tired. HAWAII QUEEN saved ground, was not a threat. MEZZANOTTE forced the issue along the four path while between foes leaving the backstretch and then tired.
