HALFWAY TO HEAVEN in hand along the four path up the backstretch, gained leaving the backstretch, dueled on the last turn, battled in the lane, responded to the whip leaving the eighth pole and drove clear. MISS CHACHA DANCER tracked the leader along the three path, dueled on the last turn with the winner, battled in the lane to no avail but finished second best. DOUBLE HI was well placed off the rail, chased the leaders in the lane and then was clearly no match for the top two finishers. I BELONG TO WINLOC was unhurried up the backstretch, four path on the last turn, angled out in the lane and then lacked the late needed response. MICH'S CURE saved ground, swung wide into the lane, was not a factor. LIVEITUPNOW broke sharply, set the pace off the rail, was hooked leaving the backstretch, chased and tired.
