LONG AND LEAN vied for the early lead outside, took command quickly down the backstretch, drew off in the lane while drifting out under steady pressure. NOW NOW GIRL tracked the pace off the rail while being rated back, moved up through the second turn on the two path, angled out in the stretch and closed well to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. ROARING BELLE well placed and outside, gained position three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid, then weakened the final furlong. CAT'S PLAYMATE passed tiring rivals inside for a share. MELODY QUEEN improved her position. SONG FOR PUPCAKE ran evenly. SILKY ME set the early pace inside and faltered. JUSTGIVEMEASECOND hopped at the start, appeared hard to rate and showed little.
