MELVINDALE broke slow, tracked along the three path, took dead aim leaving the eighth pole and nailed ROCK STAR CHARLIE on the wire. ROCK STAR CHARLIE broke on top, set the pace off the rail, was hooked late and finished gamely. THATSATRUESTORY broke slow, tracked along the four path outside the winner on the bend and weakened. THE WILEY VET saved ground well placed on the turn, angled wide in the lane and weakened. QUAD ACES was unhurried along the fence and then failed to threaten. BOSTON REGATTA five wide on the turn and weakened. ELEVEN LAFAYETTE broke slow, four path on the corner and tired. JUST ASK JOHN two path on the turn, was outrun.
