BROCK N ROLL was well placed, gained along the four path on the turn, rallied to reach the contention and then drove clear for the win. LORD SIGMUNDO vied for the lead off the rail, kicked loose some in midstretch, was no match but finished well. HE AINT EASY lagged back along the rail, gained inside in the lane and then altered out for room late while in gear. PERSIAN RULER was well placed along the rail, responded inside and finished well. SEA YA SISTA was unhurried along the four path around the bend, angled wide and rallied. TOO TOUGH JAKE broke slow, rushed up to contest the lead, dueled around the bend and then faded. SAY HALO SANDY was unhurried along the rail and weakened. BRYAN KICKS broke sluggishly, four wide on the turn and tired. LINEAR MOTION vied for the lead three across early, tracked the front-runners along the three path around the bend and gave way.
