Footnotes

FIRMAMENT in hand along the three path early, gained ground on the turn without pressure, lacked room nearing the quarter pole, checked, eased out into the lane, was set down for the drive, collared the leader late and under the whip proved best. THERES TROUBLE was well placed along the rail, moved to challenge for the lead nearing the quarter pole, took command, was hooked late, battled and then finished best of the rest. ZACHS WORLD was well placed while five wide on the turn, continued wide in the lane and then finished well. MADDIE HATTIE was unhurried along the three path on the turn, angled out widest of all in the lane and then made a mild bid. LULU'S LOVE fractious in the gate, lagged far back, saved ground, eased out in the lane, split foes late and then finished willingly. RUBY OF ROYALTY vied for the lead off the rail, battled into the lane and then faded. COUNTY DANCE lagged back along the rail and then angled out extremely wide in the lane. FRESH MARY B vied for the lead from between foes leaving the backstretch, battled into the lane and tired. STORY OF LOVE vied for the lead while three abreast leaving the backstretch, battled from between foes into the lane and tired. PATTI'S STORM ducked out at the start and then was six wide throughout. LILLY BEE BLUE saved ground, tired.
