Footnotes

SIR GUSTA vied for the lead early along the rail, continued inside while well placed on the final turn, challenged inside in midstretch and drove clear. DAVID IS MAD rated, gained along the four path on the last turn and then rallied. COLJAK well placed along the three path on the turns, three across in midstretch and then finished with interest. SECOND MORTGAGE lagged far back, four path on the turns, angled wide and made a late bid. TITLETOWN TIGER rail on the turns and hung. MATCH STICK vied for the lead early, shook loose along the two path, was hooked, battled and weakened. SHAWKLIT POWER three path on the turns and weakened. THUNDER WARRIOR saved ground and weakened. THE ARTIST well placed early, three path on the last turn and tired. CIOPPINO was well placed along the three path on the last turn, angled out into the lane, clipped heels in upper stretch with THUNDER WARRIOR, stumbled and weakened.
