ONESHOTAWAY four wide on the first turn, tracked, dueled some after a half mile, tracked again, challenged in midstretch and drew off under the whip. NOBODY LIKE MIKE broke on top, set the pace along the rail, dueled some after a half mile, cleared on the turn, was hooked and then was no match. AHYOY MATE was unhurried, four path on the last turn, angled out and was along for a share. GAVELGELD was well placed up the backstretch, two path on the last turn and then weakened. CHEROKEE RICH lagged back, saved ground, was not a factor. FIVE CASES broke slow, saved ground on the turns and tired. LUKE'S FLASH two path on the turns well placed and tired. TRI CRUSADING tracked early, four wide on the last turn, angled wide in the lane and tired.
