GAMMY'S A WINNER never far back, gained along the two path, eased out and finished well. MERLIN CIRCLE lagged back, three path on the turn, angled out and made a late bid. FREUD IAN THEORY vied for the lead along the rail, chased and weakened. EDUBAIYAH WAY hesitated at the start, broke in the air, saved ground and weakened. IS IT TUESDAY YET vied for the lead from between and weakened. STACKING THE DECK six wide up the back stretch, four path into the lane and tired.
