WATRAL'S DAHLIA was unhurried early, gained along the rail on the turn, launched a bid inside, gained the lead late and drew off. CANADIAN CAT rushed up to take command, set the pace off the rail, was hooked and then finished clearly second best. JACKIES DREAM was well placed along the four path, angled out in the lane and then lacked a solid bid. SWEET N' FROSTY tracked the leader along the four path and then weakened. ANDIAMO GOLD was unhurried along the three path and then lacked a rally. BLUE BLITZEN was well placed while five wide on the turn and tired. MISS FAIRFIELD lagged back along the three path, was outrun. ROYAL SPEECH showed little.
