GOLD GHOST gained four wide on the last turn, collared the leaders in gear and drove clear. PURA P T was unhurried along the rail, eased out for the drive and rallied. VLAST lagged back, saved ground on the final bend, eased out and rallied. HI HO SILVERMAN vied for the lead, shook clear after a half mile, was hooked on the last turn, battled in the lane and weakened. PRINCE CODY was well placed, moved to challenge on the last turn, battled between in the drive and faded. LINDSEY'S BUCK lagged back, three path on the last turn and then failed to take part. WISE GUY KELLY two path on the turns and tired. JITALIAN was well placed up the backstretch, two path on the final turn and tired. BULLSTAR vied for the lead early, tracked after a half mile and then was done on the final bend.
