VICTORYAT LAST stalked, dueled after a half mile, took charge in upper stretch and was under pressure for the score. SILKY SAINT was well placed, angled out four wide into the final bend, gained, chased and finished second best. MISS BRASS BONANZA was well placed along the rail, took the two path on the last turn, lodged a bid and finished with interest. LOST BADGE lagged back in hand, gained some along the two path on the last turn and then was going well at the end. SASSIDY never far back along the three path, entered the lane four wide and weakened. THREE BET was unhurried off the rail and then failed to gain. HELLCAT slow to load in the gate, broke slow, unhurried, four wide on the turns and then failed to take part. CRYSTAL MARKET broke sluggishly, was hustled to front, dueled after a half mile and gave way. HYPNOTIC DANCER broke in the air, checked at the seven-eighths pole, four wide into the backstretch, four wide on the final turn and tired.
