POLICY WONK vied for the lead, between foes along the three path into the lane, battled to no avail but finished second best. TRACK MAGNET was well placed along the rail, lodged a bid and finished with interest. UNCOMMON GROUNDS four path on the turn, challenged at the top of the lane, battled and weakened. LOYAL LEADER four path on the turn and then failed to threaten. FOR WES slow to load in the gate, vied for the lead along the rail and tired. DICEMAN squeezed at the start, two path on the turn and tired.
