CRAZY AS CAN BE broke sharply, sprinted clear, showed way along the rail and under the whip proved best. TOM'S HERITAGE lagged far back along the rail, angled out and rallied. FOXY MULDER tracked along the two path, responded and finished with interest. MIDNIGHT TUCKER was unhurried, four path on the turn and made a mild bid. MILLENNIUM PRIDE three path on the turn and weakened. MIKEMAMBO three path on the turn and faded. TORINO four wide on the turn and tired. JOHN THE JEWELER slow to load in the gate, saved ground and tired. BUD LIGHTNING tracked along the three path and tired.
