SHINE FOR lagged back along the three path, gained ground on the last turn, split foes into the lane, rallied, gained the lead and drove clear. FLEETENGLY was unhurried along the four path, gained ground on the last turn, angled out for the drive and finished second best. COMET BLUE was unhurried along the rail, gained ground into the lane and finished well. FAIRCHILD forced the issue along the rail, chased on the last turn and weakened. HARD TO COME BY was well placed along the three path, angled out in the lane and weakened. EBONY'S OPAL vied for the lead early while three abreast, chased on the last turn and tired. BEVERLY'S BEST vied for the lead from between foes early, shook loose, showed the way, was hooked in the lane and tired. HARD DANCING LADY saved ground, was outrun.
