WITH A CAPE was well placed along the four path on the turns, challenged three across at the top of the lane, battled and under the whip turned back GREENWOOD BOY for the win. GREENWOOD BOY was well placed along the rail, eased out leaving the backstretch, gained along the three path to challenge from between at the top of the lane, battled the winner and finished gamely. DIAMOND SHOWCASE was unhurried, gained along the three path on the turns, lodged a bid outside and finished well. BUCKY lagged back, two path on the last turn, angled out and finished with interest. LOOPY DE LOOP vied for the lead early, tracked after a half mile and weakened. OUTSIDE LOVE saved ground on the turns and weakened. BRISTOL HARBOUR five wide on the first turn, four wide on the last turn and the failed to take part. GOOD TO BE ME set the pace while pressed early, took charge after a half mile, was hooked while off the rail nearing the quarter pole and then faded.
