PENNYANNIE COWGIRL tracked along the two path, entered the lane three wide, gained and was along in time. WISEMAN'S JET broke on top, set the pace along the two path, was hooked and just missed. SIX PLUS SIX was well placed along the rail, responded and finished with good energy. JANUARY BABY two path on the turn, angled out and made a mild bid. HERESHEIS four path on the turn and then finished wide. RIDE NOW was well placed along the four path, angled wide and tired. JUSTGIVEMEASECOND reared at the start while in the hands of the assistant starter, gained along the rail and then flattened out. WHY BECAUSE four path on the turn and tired. A Stewards inquiry was posted concerning JUSTGIVEMEASECOND at the start, resulted in declaring JUSTGIVEMEASECOND a non-starter and ran for money only.
