PLAYIN'INMYWHISKEY gained four wide on the turn to challenge at the top of the lane, cleared some and under the whip outran TRINITY WARRIOR to the wire. TRINITY WARRIOR was unhurried along the rail, eased out in the lane, responded, gained and finished well. ROMAN A CLEF never far back four wide into the lane, lodged a bid to earn a share but was no match for the top pair. CHARGING ORDER broke sluggishly, tracked, challenged between some at the top of the lane, chased and weakened. THATSATRUESTORY checked at the start, saved ground, was outrun. INFILTRATOR quickly assumed the lead, set the pace off the rail, was hooked at the top of the lane and faded. WHOWHATHOW was well placed early, four wide into the lane and tired. SIDESPLITTING broke sluggishly, two path into the turn and tired.
