TOO TIRED TONIGHT was never far back five wide on the turn, angled out, chased, collared the leader and edged clear. KARAKORUM KNOCKOUT assumed command, set the pace off the rail, was hooked, battled and then finished well to best the rest. SMOKIN RACER tracked off the rail, eased out some in the lane and weakened. LABEESPA RUBIA tracked along the three path, between foes at the top of the lane and weakened. CHINA BLACK six wide up the backstretch, six wide on the turn, angled out, lodged a bid and hung. SKIPAWANDA lagged back, seven wide up the backstretch and then failed to take part. MARY'S PRAYER an early factor along the three path and tired.
