LOCAL LEGACY was well placed along the rail, gained inside on the turn to put a head in front at the top of the lane, took charge in midstretch and under the whip proved best. THE WILEY VET lagged back along the rail, responded inside in the lane and rallied. TIMOTHY'S BOY vied for the lead three across into the lane, chased and finished with interest. WISTFUL WILDCAT was well placed along the three path, angled out and hung. HOPE FOR SPRING was unhurried, four wide on the turn and then finished wide. DISTINCTIVE LOVER broke slow, four wide on the turn and then finished well out in the strip. ROAD TO LOVE was well placed two from the rail on the turn and weakened. EYE WITNESS vied for the lead from between early, between foes into the lane on the pace and then faded. BRASSTOWN SHERIFF two path on the turn and tired inside.
