CLASSIC IMPACT was never far back, gained along the rail on the last turn, eased out, collared the leaders in midstretch and drew off to be a ridden out winner. CAPTAIN NOAH stalked the leader, challenged from between foes in midstretch to no avail but finished well. JACKIE'S PUNT four path on the first turn, gained along the three path into the lane and finished with interest. TINTAGLE was unhurried, gained along the four path on the last turn and flattened out. DIGITAL AGE set the pace to midstretch and weakened. AGRIGENTO lagged back, angled out five wide into the lane and then lacked a rally. DARNAB DAB broke sluggishly, lagged back, five wide on the last turn and then finished wide. TOM'S PRIMETIME six wide on the first turn, five wide on the last turn and tired. HEY JOHNNY JOHNNY five wide on the first turn, well placed off the rail on the last turn and tired. JIM JACK N JOHNNIE ducked out at the start, six wide on the first turn and then was done on the last turn.
