ADIRONDACK WARRIOR was unhurried six wide into the backstretch, five wide after a half mile, gained four wide on the last turn, continued wide in lane, responded well out in the strip and bested PRINCE RAFFIE on the line. PRINCE RAFFIE was unhurried two from the rail up the backstretch, gained some off the rail on the last turn, responded inside in the lane and closed determinedly to just miss. STOUT HOPE broke on top, vied for the lead three off the rail up the backstretch with LEGAL TENDORA, put that one away on the last turn, remained clear a furlong out but could not sustain the bid. TEN BELLS broke slow, checked shortly after the start, gained along the rail into the final bend, chased in the lane and weakened. TITUSVILLE lagged back, two path on the turns and then found his best stride late. EMPIRE EXPRESS unhurried seven wide into the backstretch, five around the last turn and then finished wide. ONE LITTLE SECRET never far back, three path on the turns and tired. LEGAL TENDORA vied for the lead along the four path up the backstretch, three path on the last turn and tired.
