AL'S LARK was unhurried along the four path, angled out six wide into the lane, collared the leaders and then drifted out late while under the whip for the win. MARSH DAWG ducked out at the start, unhurried along the four path, angled wide in the lane, gained and then was forced out late while finishing well. ON WITH IT vied for the lead from between foes two deep, battled in the lane and weakened. PATRON SAINT vied for the lead from between foes five deep into the lane, lodged a bid and weakened. INDIAN RUSH vied for the lead from between foes four deep into the lane and weakened. EASTLAKE vied for the lead from between foes three deep and tired. NEW SPIRIT (CHI) vied for the lead along the rail and gave way. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of MARSH DAWG against the winner for interference in deep stretch, resulted in no change.
