POLICY WONK broke well, set the pace and then widened while drifting out through the final sixteenths. SARATOGA COWBOY was unhurried along the rail, responded inside and finished with good energy. FENWAY SOX five wide on the turn and then finished with interest. READY VICTORY forced the issue early, tracked along the three path and weakened. MONY'S KEEPER fractious in the gate, four path on the turn and weakened. HEADLINE HUNTER was unhurried, three path on the turn and then lacked a rally. ITS GOODTOBEKING lunged at the start spotting the field two lengths, rushed up, two path on the turn and weakened. OUT BID forced the issue some, four path on the turn and tired. COURAGEOUS GENERAL showed little along the rail.
